		Animal Testing	NGS	Comments
X	Detection range	×	✓	NGS has a broader range of detection as <i>in vivo</i> testing. Entire families of viruses cannot be detected with animal testing.
*	Specificity for virus identification	×	✓	NGS detection is based on sequencing, which ensures virus detection and identification. Detection using animal models is based on clinical signs which are not specific to viruses and need further investigation for identification.
	Sensitivity	×	✓	As shown in this study, NGS has greater or equal sensitivity compared to most animal testing.
	Turnaround time	×	✓	Suckling mice assay takes 28 days for observation period alone. Animal testing failures are common (increased TAT)
	3Rs compliance	×	\checkmark	Directive 2010/63/EU requires Replacement, Reduction, and Refinement of animal testing whenever possible
	Validation	×	✓	Animal testing is not validated (due to ethical concerns), NGS is available at a GMP grade. New ICHQ5A(R2) adopted in 2023 and EP 5.2.14 clearly state the use of NGS as an alternative.
	Regulatory acceptance	✓	✓	EP 2.6.16 requires justification for the use of animal testing whereas NGS is considered an acceptable alternative method.
